Van Dirk Fisher, the founder and artistic director of the Riant Theatre and producer of the long-running critically acclaimed Strawberry One-Act Festival, presents a dynamic new improvisational show called *WHO'S GOT GAME?* Performances are at 6pm on Sundays from now through December 17th and will be at The Times Square Arts Center, 300 West 43rd Street, Roy Arias Theatre, 6th floor.

In this improvisational comedy show, twenty actors have been chosen to compete for the title of "Best Playa Playa." Each week the actors will partner and compete to win points from the judges and from the audience. At the end of the night the audience will cast their votes and decide *WHO'S GOT GAME?* And each week one team of two actors will be eliminated. The actors who manage to make it to the final show on Sunday, December 17th will then compete for a CASH PRIZE of \$500.00! But the cash prizes don't stop there.
